## Couples Golf Format

## $1^{\text {st }}$ NINE

- GAME-Alternating shot.

That is, each 2-person teams play the same ball throughout the round of golf, alternating shots: The first player tees off, the second player hits the second shot, the first player hits the third shot, and so on until the ball is holed. If the first Player made the last putt on the preceding hole, then the second player tees off on the next hole.

- Both players will tee off on the first hole played and the team can choose to play either tee shot determining the first player.
- Additionally, on the front nine, teams will need to keep track of the number of putts on each hole (We will include a line for this on the score card)
- Players should play winter rules, bumping the ball as necessary.
- Prizes will be awarded for $1^{\text {st }}, 2^{\text {nd }}, 3^{\text {rd }}, 4^{\text {th }}$ and three mystery games.
