Hopefully with these milder temps we have been having you've been out swinging your clubs thinking about tearing up your flight in Men's League this year. Who am I kidding, no one thinks about Men's League this time of year except me. Yes, I have begun the annual ritual of planning for this year's League.

First, I want to point out some of the accomplishments of last year's league to all of the participants and all of the other club members. The 2006 Men's League concluded their season with 39 teams and 45 substitutes, which means we had 184 members participating in the league. Once again the league is growing. Who knows what 2007 will bring. Additionally we cleared over \$2000 to be used for improvements to our Country Club. Our proceeds have been ear marked for a new Tournament pavilion with a scoreboard. As you all can see the concrete pad for this structure has already been poured.

Now for 2007, the league fee will be \$144 per team. This fee must be paid in full when you turn in your team's application. We will have a MANDATORY league meeting in late, the date will be announced after we know the clubhouse remodel schedule. Please send at least one member from your team. Additionally, all subs must be present at this meeting. At this meeting we will go over league rules and other changes. League will be held mainly on Tuesday nights with the overflow on Thursdays.

Entry deadline is March 30th at 5:00pm – NO EXCEPTIONS!! Please return all forms to the clubhouse. Forms must be received at the Club no later than the 30th so be careful if you mail them. Please include your team's payment with the entry form. League will start on Tuesday, April 24th.

This year ALL subs must be on the sub list in order to play. If you have a sub that is not on the list playing on your team during a match, that match will be forfeited.
