A Note from Mark- PLEASE repair your ball marks on the greens (fix one or two others also). Unrepaired ball marks take two to three weeks to properly heal, leaving behind unsightly, uneven putting surfaces. A repaired ball mark only takes half that time to heal.

PLEASE pick up your broken tees (and one or two others also) from the tee boxes. Broken tees wreak havoc on the mower blades, and cause unnecessary and unscheduled sharpening.

& Lastly, PLEASE obey the Cart Path sign at the men's tee box. This time of year is touch & go with respect to the weather and allowing the 90-degree rule to be utilized.
